Questions/comments - nothing

February minutes, Feb 26th Special and March 9th Special were presented. Amend minutes to show that Keith was present. Ed made a motion to approve the monthly meeting minutes, 2nd by Keith Motion carried

Kyle Johansen was present to discuss the rezoning request for Peterson. At the town level, the town board evaluates the change and if they approve it goes to the county, if they disapprove it stops. Request a change from RA-5 to B-2 recreational business vs rent out for and Air B and B. Motion to approve the change was made by Ed. 2nd by Ryan. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was presented - The balance 2/28/26 was \$5,048.39 in Frandsen and MM is \$5,029.58. RCU is 102,776.75. Sterling Checking account is \$22,658.58 and the MM is at \$402,855.79. Ryan made a motion to accept the report. Keith 2nd it. Motion carried.

After reviewing the bills totaling \$55,733.38, Ed made a motion to pay all bills. Keith 2nd it, Motion carried.

Discussion and motion made by Keith to approve the operator's license for Mitchell Bengston and Trevor Meiners. 2nd by Ed. Motion carried.

Patrolman's report - Have been busy cutting trees. And have already gone through one load of patch. But snowing now - but will not run out of salt sand. Will have a special meeting 3/26 for bid coming out in the paper tomorrow. All the roads are now posted

Appointment of poll workers - Ed made a motion to appoint Nancy Schilling, Nancy Priebe, Karen Craker, Andy Kasparec and Nick Shaffar. 2nd by Keith. Motion carried.

Set the date and time for the annual meeting and the monthly April meeting. Ed made a motion to have both on April 21st - the annual at 7:00 and the monthly at 7:30. 2nd by Keith. Motion carried.

Discussion of wake board ordinance. Decided to wait and see what the Village decides but if they don't, we will just think about Little Butternut.

Ed made a motion to go into closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 19.85(1)(b) and (c). Keith 2nd it. Motion carried.

Ed made a motion to go back into open session. 2nd by Ryan. Motion carried.

Danielle Park signed the contract for treasurer for and annual salary of \$7000 payable quarterly. Ed made the motion. Ryan 2nd it. Motion carried.
